

Q: How long will live (synchronous) calls be?

A: Live synchronous calls will last between 20 and 30 minutes. Our 2s and 3s may need to work up to that length of time as we would spend time in the in-person classroom lengthening their attention span.

Calls will begin with a welcome/check-in and include a mini lesson regarding the curricular item or standard we're addressing. We'll then move to a song or finger play/action item, have time to share and then a routine closure to the meeting.

The synchronous model lends itself well to establishing a schedule/routine which is extremely valuable at this age. Routines give children (and adults) a sense of security in knowing what to expect/what is coming next.
